Job Responsibilities:

- Typical work schedule is Sunday through Friday with some additional camp sessions through the summer
- Be able to commit to entire camp season – late May through mid-August.
- Must be age 18 or older.
- Attend all mandatory training sessions, staff meetings, and in services. Training dates will be June 3, 4 and 5, 2019.
- Supervise all assigned aspects of the campers' day including morning rise and shine, cabin clean up, meal times, rest hour, all camp activities, preparing for bed, general camper hygiene, and after hours duty.
- Be prepared to either assist or lead camp activity sessions.
- Fulfill all required certifications - CPR, First Aid and Child Abuse Prevention. These trainings will be offered through your employment with the Y.
- Maintain good public relations with campers' parents.
- Follow camp rules and regulations pertaining to smoking, alcoholic beverages and use of drugs.
- Set a good example for campers and others including cleanliness, punctuality, sharing clean up and chores, sportsmanship and table manners.
- Will AT ALL TIMES be responsible for insuring SAFETY OF ALL CAMPERS throughout camp session
- Keep camp clean and safe for all campers and staff
- Insure the preservation of the natural environment of the camp setting

Job Responsibilities:

- Typical workday is from 7:30–4:30, Monday through Friday. There will be exceptions according to which camp you are working a particular week.
- Be able to commit to entire camp season – late May through mid-August.
- Attend all mandatory training sessions, staff meetings, and in services. Training dates will be June 3, 4 and 5, 2019.
- Work with assigned group of 8-10 campers and be responsible for group at all times
- Assist in establishing, maintaining and developing staff unity and communication between LIT's, LIT Coordinator, and Camp Director
- Be responsible for diverse program experiences for assigned group during camp period
- Be responsive to campers needs and wherever possible involve group in decision making
- Will AT ALL TIMES be responsible for insuring SAFETY OF ALL CAMPERS throughout camp session
- Keep camp clean and safe for all campers and staff
- Ensure the preservation of the natural environment of the camp setting
- Maintain a neat appearance; wearing appropriate staff shirts
- Follow all policies and guidelines

Theater Camp Counselor based out of the Y – Ages 16 and older

Job Responsibilities:

- Typical workday is from 7:30–4:30, Monday through Friday.
- Attend all mandatory training sessions, staff meetings, and in services. Training dates will be June 3, 4 and 5, 2019.
- Be able to commit to 3 separate theater-based camps:
 - June 24–June 28: Theater Camp I
 - July 15–19: Exploring Theater
 - July 22–26: Theater Camp II
- Work with campers in small group settings developing their performance abilities and be responsible for your group at all times.
- Thoroughly learn (not memorize) the lines and songs of the productions we are showcasing.
- Demonstrate vocal and theatrical concepts for campers (i.e. harmonizing, staging, etc.).
- Lead productive group rehearsals using positive and clear feedback, classroom management and an understanding of daily timelines.
- Engage with campers as frequently as possible, even when you are not the lead instructor (singing along, checking page numbers, pulling a small group, etc.).
- Participate in performances as a member of the backstage crew.
- Be responsive to campers needs, and wherever possible, involve group in decision making.
- **AT ALL TIMES** be responsible for ensuring **SAFETY** of **ALL CAMPERS** throughout the camp session.
- Keep camp clean, safe and organized for all campers and staff.
